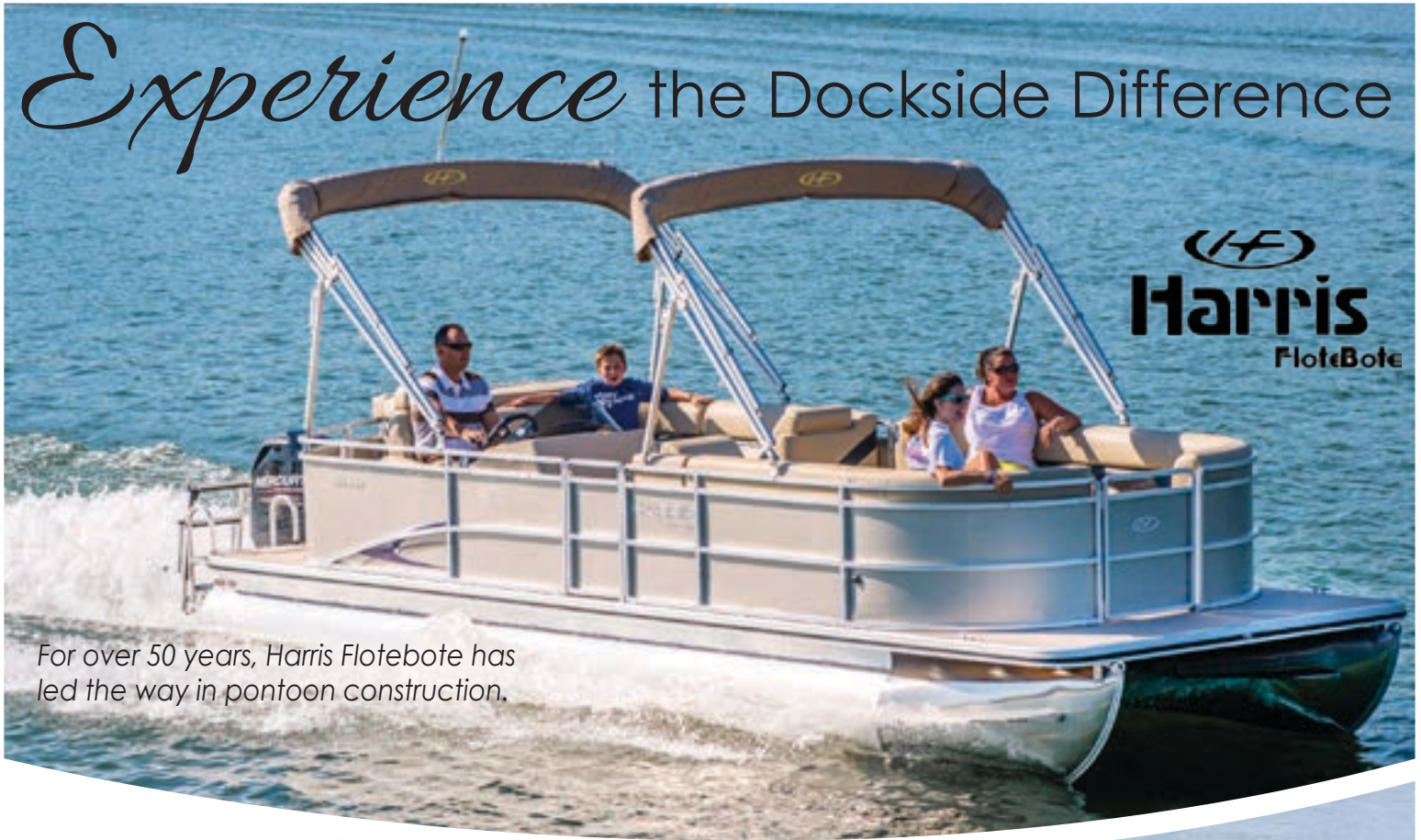

## Bar Director's Report

**W**OW how did it become fall - a great summer has flown by. It is time to switch gears to the Fall/Winter Season and find some fun things to do in our cooler seasons.

We have completed a small upgrade to our Bar. We installed new taps so each Bartender Station will have the ability to serve all beverages easily. We removed the old beer tower that still said Molson's and was large and unsightly, installing two new stainless steel towers that will feature two beers, one red wine and one white wine tap on each tower. We will keep our two beers, Pilsner and Thirsty Beaver and will have Peller Estates Pinot Grigio and Cab. Sauvignon as our house wines which will be available by the 6oz glass, 9 oz. glass and litre. We will eliminate the boxed wines on the counter which will speed up service and give our Bar area a cleaner, less cluttered look. We will have wines by the bottle, as well as feature wines. Feature wines by the

glass will be available dependent on business levels, available during busy events.

To try to keep our members coming to club during the non-boating season we are producing a calendar of fun events to bring you out to enjoy the club with your club friends. We are setting up fun evening events such as: hockey nights, football nights, games nights, pool leagues and tournaments, some ladies events and perhaps even Karaoke nights. Our first flyer went so come and enjoy our club during our fall and winter months. We are working to set up a pool league that will start in January, and looking for 16 teams (2 person teams) to play in this league. We are thinking of Thursday night for this event. 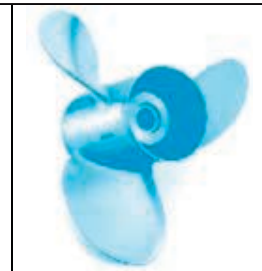
